### MEMORANDUM

A Baseline Assessment was conducted for all Class 2 students in September 2023 to understand the on – ground scenario pertaining to our students' learning in Literacy and Numeracy. In this regard, all the District Education Officers have taken necessary steps to help the slow learners to come up at par with other students in the classrooms.

Now an Endline Assessment is to be conducted for all the students of class III across the state.

In this regard the following activities have been already completed:

1. The Assessment Tools have already been vetted by SCERT.
2. Master trainers have been identified among the BRPs, CRPs and NIPUN Coordinators.
3. A training for the Master Trainers on the Endline Assessment tools has been organized on 10-05-2024 at Muktodhara Auditorium, so that they will train the teachers in a cascading manner.
4. One day Orientation session for the District Education Officers, Inspectors of Schools, BRC Coordinators, BRPs and CRPs have been organized on 15-06-2024 at Muktheadhara Auditorium Agartala.

Now, upon completion of the said trainings and Orientations, the District Education Officers are requested to engage the selected Master Trainers to start the training of teachers and observers in their respective blocks. While doing so, not less than 2 teachers from each school shall be trained for the purpose. The whole process in the block level shall be mentored and monitored by Inspector of Schools and the entire process of training the teachers and observers must be completed within first week of July 2024. The End line Assessment is planned to be conducted in the second week of July.

In this process the number of teachers to be trained per district is as below:
