

MEMORANDUM

During visit in the schools, it is observed that more involvement of teachers is required for strengthening of foundational academic activities among the students at primary level. Moreover, final examination of the students has been scheduled from 12-03-2025 and for this, revision of syllabus is very much essential for the students.

In view of the above, it is decided to observe the **Foundational Literacy & Numeracy (FLN) week** w.e.f 17-02-2025, for **“Two Weeks”**, for **Class-I to V**, in all **Independent Jr. Basic and Sr. Basic Schools**. All Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools are excluded from the above activity as examination will commence in the schools.

1. All schools should ensure the attendance of students in the classes.
2. During observation of FLN Week the following activities should be done:-
 - Loud Reading of texts from prescribed syllabus, focusing on comprehension, fluency and vocabulary enhancement and revision of syllabus for the examination to be held from 12-03-2025.
 - Students should be encouraged to write contents including question-answers from prescribed syllabus.
 - Class appropriate Numeracy should be practiced regularly.
3. It is also instructed that special focus should be given by teachers on slow learners during the entire two weeks.
4. All Inspector of Schools should visit all the independent JB, SB schools under their jurisdiction to ensure proper observation of **FLN Week** and submit a report, along with geo-tagged photos outlining the activities conducted, student's participation and feedback on the event, to the concerned DEO on the last day i.e., on **01/03/2025**.
5. Inspector of Schools are also instructed to ensure that all concerned schools should display a colourful flex in the prominent place of schools, for awareness of Guardians and Community members.
6. To encourage the students during various activities under **FLN Week**, students of each grade should be awarded. The necessary arrangement for this purpose should be done by concerned Inspector of Schools. The necessary fund for this purpose will be disbursed in favor of the Office of DEO, for disbursement to concerned offices of Inspector of Schools.
7. All DEOs along with OSDs are also requested to visit at least 20% schools of concerned District to monitor the process.
8. All Officers of DEE are also requested to visit the schools during this period.
