Memo

To ensure effective and quality learning of pre-primary and primary student's, regular school inspection and hand holding of teachers is essential. In this regard, from commencement of the academic session 2026-27 regular school inspection should be prioritized and during inspection the following points must be ensured:-

- Effective implementation of Vidyasetu module.
- Emphasis on development of hand-made Teaching-learning materials (TLMs)
- Daily use of Jadui Pitara TLMs.
- Use of TLMs from NIPUN Corner and its maintenance.
- Implementation of Mission Mukul.
- Class appropriate learning.
- Monitoring and use of IT resources available in schools.
- Proper implementation of PM POSHAN Scheme.

In this regard, District Education officers, OSDs, Inspector of Schools, Deputy Inspector of Schools, BRPs and CRPs must visit schools on regular basis following the below cited guidelines as per memo No.F.4(99)-DEE-GEN-2021, Dated 23/12/2025.


1. **District Education Officer / Principal Officer (Edn), TTAADC- 06 / month**
2. **OSDs posted in District Education Office - 08 / month**
3. **Inspector of Schools (State & TTAADC) - 10 / month**
4. **Dy. Inspector of Schools (State & TTAADC) - 14 / month**
5. **BRPs & CRPs - 20 / month**

Responsibility will be fixed upon the concerned officers / officials who are found to be negligent in inspecting schools.

Headmasters / TICs of primary section are requested to ensure that **NIPUN corners remain in FLN classrooms. Principals / Headmasters of noon shift must ensure that primary section has NIPUN corner in FLN classrooms instead of staffroom or in any separate room.**

Headmasters / TICs of primary section are further requested to encourage teachers to **develop hand-made TLMs as per students need on Literacy, Numeracy, Healthy hygiene practices etc. during the month of February and March**, so that the NIPUN corners become enriched with TLMs before commencement of academic session 2026-27. In addition to that low height black boards 360° surrounding the classroom should be developed in pre-primary to Grade-2 classes so that students can freely write and scribble in the boards. Headmasters of primary and noon section will ensure construction of the board before commencement of new academic session 2026-27.

In this regard, responsibility will be fixed upon Principals / Headmasters of Noon Section, Primary Section / TIC.




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Inspection should be conducted by all Officers and Officials during the month of February and March, 2026 also to ensure that all the preparations for new academic session 2026-27 are updated accordingly for smooth commencement of new academic year.

DEOs are further requested to disseminate the above information to all concerned for effective implementation of the process.
