MEMORANDUM

Subject: Use of "Samiksha Sahayak (Tripura)" and "Smart Assessment Tripura" Bots on the SwiftChat Application for School Inspection and Student Assessment.

In continuation of this Directorate Memo No. F.30(1-17)/DEE/NIPUNTripuraCell/2024 (Loose)/1694 dated 18-02-2026 regarding school inspection, and Directorate Memorandum No. F.29(14)/DEE/Training/Pre-Pry/2021/L-1/311 dated 04-06-2026 regarding the One-Day Hands-on Workshop on the Upcoming Online School Monitoring and Assessment Format at ECCE & FLN Level, through which all concerned field-level functionaries were trained on the use of the online school monitoring and assessment system.

Now, it is hereby informed that, all field-level monitoring and supervisory officers/functionaries shall adopt the digital system for school inspection and student assessment through the SwiftChat application.

Accordingly, the following instructions shall be complied with by all concerned:

1. All Inspectors of Schools (State & TTAADC), Deputy Inspectors of Schools (State & TTAADC), Block Resource Persons (BRPs), Cluster Resource Persons (CRPs), and other officers/officials entrusted with school visits, inspections, monitoring, or student learning assessment shall compulsorily use:
 - "Samiksha Sahayak (Tripura)" Bot for school inspection, monitoring, and reporting; and
 - "Smart Assessment Tripura" Bot for conducting student assessments and recording learning outcomes.
2. All school inspection reports and student assessment data shall be captured and submitted only through the respective bots on the SwiftChat application during field visits.
3. All BRP's and CRP's are instructed to assess the progress of FLN grade students in every 15 days interval.

The successful implementation of this digital monitoring and assessment system is essential for strengthening and improving the quality of school supervision, and enhancing learning outcomes under the Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) Mission. Therefore, strict compliance with this memorandum is mandatory.
