### **Memorandum**

In reference to the letter D.O.No.1-1/2025-IS.13, Dated 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2025, received from the Department of School Education & Literacy (DoSE&L), Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, all District Education Officers (DEOs) are hereby requested to disseminate the information to all concerned that to fulfill the vision of NEP-2020, the Department of School Education & Literacy (DoSE&L), Ministry of Education has launched **“Baalpan ki Kavita initiative: Restoring Bhartiya rhymes / poems for young children”** to prepare a compendium of nursery rhymes / poems in all Bhartiya Bhasha and also in English, focusing on content relevant to the Indian context holding cultural significance.

The purpose of this initiative is that the young children can have better learning at the Foundational stage by becoming familiar with the world around them. This is a collaborative initiative of DoSE&L and MyGov.

The participants of the contest can send existing poems/rhymes popular in folklore (mentioning the name of author) or can newly compose joyful poems/rhymes under three categories:

- Pre-primary (ages 3-6)
- Grade 1 (ages 6-7)
- Grade 2 (ages 7-8)

Participants need to register and submit their entries on the **MyGov website (<http://www.mygov.in/>)** between **26<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 to 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2025**. Other details of the competition is available on MyGov Website.

Participants need not to pay any entry fee for participation. The finally selected participants by the Selection Committee will receive a certificate of contribution and appropriate cash reward.

In this connection, DEOs are requested to take necessary measures for wide publicity, ensuring maximum participation of students and teachers of the state.

Aiming wide publicity of the competition social media platforms, websites and portals, posters and flyers etc. may be used along with organizing awareness sessions or workshops in schools, local media, community outreach etc.
